Activity	Safe operating of hair salon during Covid19 pandemic				

Description:

The Hair Base take the safety of its staff and customers extremely seriously and will ensure implementation of safe and effective social distancing and hygiene measures in line with government advice to limit the potential for infection. This risk assessment covers all activities associated with the hair salon and details additional measures implemented to address the Covid19 pandemic.

Estimation of risk:

High risk: Almost certain or imminent chance of major injury/damage, lost time, business interruption, or disablement. Medium risk: An even chance that it may happen and may lead to lost time, injury, illness, damage or lost business. Low risk: Improbable chance, unlikely to happen, or negligible risk (delay only).

This risk assessment must be read in conjunction with all other activity and site-specific risk assessments in relation to the tasks you are undertaking.

Risk of infection from Covid 19	Staff and customers	Staff are reminded that they must self- isolate in accordance with government guidance and get a coronavirus test if they develop symptoms.		
		Management will send home any member of staff who displays symptoms if that individual fails to comply appropriately.		
		Staff are remined to stay away from work should a member of their household develop symptoms, pending the outcome of a coronavirus test on that household member.		
		Staff are reminded that they must self- isolate for 14 days should they receive such instructions from the NHS Track and Trace service.		
		For those staff who are on site, everyone will always remain 2m apart, or 1m with risk mitigation where 2m is not viable, is acceptable. Operations and locations will be designed accordingly		
		The number of clients permitted on site will be limited, and appointments will be managed via a central booking system with allocated time slots to ensure the

Cleaning of premises during pandemic		Hand contact points will be cleaned and sanitised regularly throughout the day. Each station will be sanitised for 15 mins in between clients Toilet cleaning will be undertaken as a minimum 3 times a day and staff will complete the toilet cleaning schedule. Disposable paper towels are provided in the toilets.	Medium Risk	



Risk from transmission of infection between staff and client interactions Staff are requested to observe the following: Hair must be tied up No rings or hand jewellery No long sleeve tops Face visors are to be worn at all times where 2 meters cannot be observed Staff must complete a daily health checklist form and have temperature taken and recorded Staff are requested not to leave salon on lunch break and lunch breaks will be staggered throughout the day. 		Clients will be taken directly to the station and will be provided with a basket to place their belongings in which will be taken to the station with them	Wedidili Nisk	
		A Perspex screen is provided at reception. Where possible clients will be checked out in their seat using contactless payment and their next appointment emailed directly to them.		
		During the pandemic no magazines will be available in the salon. Clients are requested not to bring food
